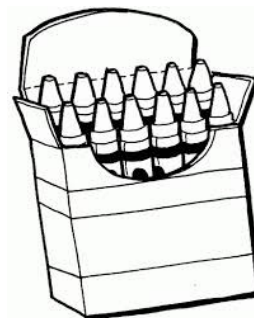

- 1 box Kleenex

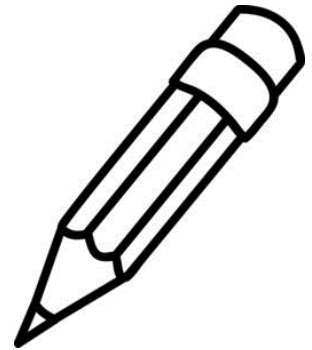

Dear Future Second Grade Parents,

We are looking forward to seeing you and your child in second grade next fall. Here is a list of the items your child should have on their first day of school.

- 1 bottle of glue
- 1 pack of 24 pencils
- One solid colored 1" three ring binder (usually 88¢ on sale)
- 1 pack of 24 crayons
- Scissors
- 2 pink bar erasers
- 4 glue sticks
- 4 dry erase markers (Expo or Sanford brand)
- 1 spiral bound notebook with 50 - 100 pages
- school box (5"x8")
- Kleenex (3 boxes)
- One ream of copy paper
- **1 headset for personal computer use (you can reuse 1st grade headset or buy a new one just like it) Please do not buy earbuds. Many students find them uncomfortable. They also do not store well and become tangled easily. THIS IS USED DAILY AND IS A VERY IMPORTANT ITEM.**

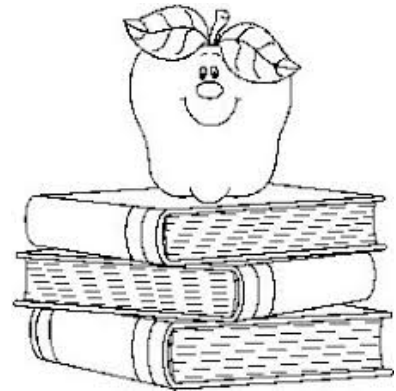
