



What is 4-H?

It's "learn by doing". You get interested in a project and learn how to make it or take care of it. 4-H is a "hands-on" learning experience.

Who can be in 4-H?

Anyone in grades 3-12 at the time of enrollment can be in traditional 4-H. Any youth in grades K-2 at the time of enrollment can be in Mini 4-H.

What are 4-H projects?

Just a few examples: aerospace, crafts, photography, bicycle, electric, foods, dogs, and livestock.

Does it cost to join?

Yes. There is a fee to help cover the cost of 4-H manuals, scholarships, and other fees. The fee is \$20 and there are scholarships to cover those with need. The only other costs will be for the materials to make whatever 4-H project you decide to make for the fair.
